Managers Report:



The days are getting shorter and time to think about curling again.

We turn on compressors Sept 1st and will be ready to curl Sept 14th. There will be lots of open ice to practice. We will have clinics and a few open houses before our regular leagues start on the week of the 21st of Sept and on. Time to recruit new members to the game of curling and I could use your help.

This year we are going to try a Saturday evening league (6:30pm) to attract new people to the game called the Okanagan Spring 6 Pack League. The league will play 6 Saturdays between October to December and another 6 pack session between January and March. Cost is \$90 for 6 sessions, no membership fee charged. We need you to find people that have always wanted to try curling to get them out to the club. Each session we will have a half hour on ice instruction, followed by a 6 end game, then each player will receive 1 beer token courtesy of Okanagan Spring Brewery. We really need club members to help out with instruction and guidance on Saturday evenings. Lets make this happen, I need your help!!!

We need to think about the future of our club. I think it is going to be very important in the next few years to recruit new members to the game of curling. Along with the 6 Pack League, we need to ensure the Junior Program continues to grow, so if you have time to offer please let us know. The Junior league runs Mondays from 3:30 – 5pm.

Prestige Curling Classic starts Sept 28th and goes to Oct 1st, there is no charge to come down and watch some of the best teams in the world play. Also, this year we are hosting the Everest Canadian Seniors Championships from Dec 3-10. We will require many volunteers to help ensure we put on a great event. More news about this to follow.

The locker rooms look awesome, we painted and cleaned things up. Thanks to all those that volunteered. We replaced the bar area with new counters and cleaned things up and it looks great. I will be getting a group of volunteers together to paint the lower lounge area after the long weekend in September. The **website** is new this year and hopefully registration will be easy to do when it is up and running. Check it out from time to time for updates. AGM is September 17th at 6:30, we read reports, AGM starts sharp at 7pm followed by presentation of awards and Championship jackets and shirts. Each adult member pays this once every year, regardless of the number of leagues in which they register. If you are a <u>first-time member</u>, this membership fee is waived for your first year of curling. The Club Membership Fee includes the Capital Improvement Fee as well as CurlBC Association Dues. Those members who supported the club with the SHARE THE LOAD LOAN will receive a \$25 reduction.

All 60+ Senior daytime men and women are required to pay a \$4 BCIMCA fee

CLUB POLICY... All League Dues MUST be paid in full BEFORE the first game

Team - a team is responsible for registering and paying league dues for 4 players. If a team wishes to register more than 4 players those additional players must pay the Club Membership and league social fees.

Registered Team Member - any player who has paid the Club Membership and league social fees and is listed as a player on a specific team is considered a registered team member and can play any position for that team.

<u>Club Spare</u> – Cost to be a club spare is \$75, plus the \$75 membership fee (\$150). Alternatively, a person can purchase a 5-game punch pass for \$60. If they wish to spare additional games, they must pay to become a fully paid club spare (additional \$90).

A fully paid club spare can curl an unlimited number of games in any league with organized teams as long as that team already has 4 fully paid team members.

A fully paid club member may spare in any league for any team at no extra charge, as long as that team already has 4 fully paid team members. All spares must abide by that leagues spare rules.

<u>Senior Men's Drop-in</u> - All participants must pay the Club Membership Fee to play in this league. They can join the league or purchase a \$60 punch card for initial 5 games. Additional games will require them to join the league and pay the difference.

Membership Fee - will be waived for curlers joining the Vernon Curling Club for the very first time.

MENS EVENING LEAGUES: These leagues are all fixed men's teams.

Teams are divided into divisions to ensure teams play amongst their calibre.

MONDAY 6:30pm

TUESDAY 6:30pm, with an occasional 8:30pm game **THURSDAY 6:30pm**, with an occasional 8:30pm game

LADIES LEAGUES:

TUESDAY/THURSDAY 1:30pm

Some teams have players sharing the Tue/Thu spot if they wish to only curl once a week.

WEDNESDAY EVENING 6:30pm

WEDNESDAY 9 am: Perfect league for those of you who are looking for a break in your weekly routine, to get back into the game of curling, or discover it for the first time. All ages welcome and all levels of curling ability. Sign up as an individual and teams will be made prior to the start of the season. Latecomers are also welcome. This is a very comfortable, social league.

MIXED LEAGUES:

FRIDAY EVENING 6:30pm: This is a true mixed league. Teams are divided into divisions depending on experience. Teams, couples and individuals welcome. Games at 6:30pm and occasionally 8:30pm **SENIOR FRIDAY AFTERNOON 2pm**: This league caters to the 50+ crowd. It is a great social atmosphere and is very popular. All levels of curlers from novice to experienced are welcome.

SENIOR LEAGUES:

MENS TUE/THU DROP-IN 10am: This is a drop-in league for senior men 50+. Can play Tue & Thu or just 1 day. 1/2 season or punch card available. We welcome beginner to competitive.

MENS FRIDAY MORNING 9am: This is a fixed team competitive league for senior men 50+.

LADIES MON/WED AFTERNOON 1pm: Sign up as an individual and teams will be made prior to the start of the season. Can play either Mon or Wed, or both. 1/2 season available.

MIXED FRIDAY AFTERNOON 2pm: see above description.

OPEN LEAGUES

STICK Wed 9am: This league has ice on Wednesday's from 9am to 1 pm. Teams consist of 2 players. Play two 6- end games. Open to all players, ages & abilities.

DOUBLES SUN noon: A 2-person team, men or women or mixed. Two 6-end games. 10 Sundays from Oct to March.

SATURDAY 6-PACK 6:30pm: Instruction will be provided for 1/2 hour followed by a 6-end game. Includes a free beer after the game provided by **OKANAGAN SPRING BREWERY**
